They will share creative solutions for supporting families with unstable housing and other housing needs. In addition, we will hear a policy update from Casey Family Programs and learn about resources developed by its Knowledge Management team. Edwin Daye is a dedicated father advocate. He is also the founder and director of Patron's Hands for Dads located in Des Moines, Iowa. Established in 2011, Patron's House, named after his son, provides fathers with needed supports while working to regain custody of their children. It was founded by Edwin as a way to give back to his community. His own experiences in regaining custody of his son Patron led to his involvement in supporting other fathers. Patron's Hands offers housing, visitation assistance, employment counseling, and linkage to treatment and other services as well as support during Team Decision-Making meetings and court hearings. Edwin is trained as a 24/7 Dad facilitator for multiple fatherhood groups.

Kimberly Mays is a passionate advocate for families in Washington and nationwide. She has developed an innovative approach to help families access housing and other needed resources. Kimberly established a clean and sober recovery home for families in 2016 in Washington. She has expanded and now oversees seven recovery homes. Through this program, Kimberly assists families with a wide range of services including finding jobs or linking them to higher education resources, assisting with mental health and other outpatient services. She also provides families with guidance and financial assistance to cover housing or help with buy their own home. Due to Kimberly's hard work, many families are able to achieve reunification. The highly successful housing program is a much needed and sought after resource for families.
