## Building Blocks to Successful Partnerships

#### **Audience**

Better Together: Building Blocks to Successful Partnerships is designed to help birth parents, foster parents, kinship caregivers and staff to help build equal and mutually respectful partnerships among each other.

#### Purpose

This is a two-day experiential workshop that fosters equal, mutually respectful partnerships among staff, birth parents, foster parents and kinship caregivers. The core components of the program include:

- 1. The benefits of partnering with constituents.
- 2. Key aspects of meaningful partnerships
- 3. The value of interacting with other participants to learn from each other and understand others' perspectives
- 4. Exploring culture as it relates to foster care and meaningful partnerships; and
- 5. The importance of developing a vision of effective partnerships by discussing the skills needed and identifying the barriers and bridges to partnerships.

### **Learning Outcomes**

As a result of attending this workshop, participants will be able to:

- Understand the value of communicating respectfully, honestly and often.
- Identify commonly valued outcomes for children, families, birth parents, foster parents, kinship caregivers and communities.
- Gain an awareness of how issues that impact interactions between birth parents, foster parents, kinship caregivers and staff/allies.
- Gain an understanding of different beliefs and honor/respect them.
- Explore and experience the meaning of shared decision-making and shared parenting.
- Gain an understanding of the systemic issues and their implications for juvenile justice and child protective services.
- Understand the specific needs and perspectives of fathers/parenting partners.
- Gain an increased awareness of the reality of the issues faced by the "other" (parent, foster parent, kinship caregiver and staff/ally).
- Gain an increased understanding of the power differential between birth parents, foster parents, kinship caregivers, social work staff and allies in order begin a discussion of shared decision-making.
- Better understand and engage the strengths of all team members.
- Improve dialogue and work toward stronger partnership and understanding between birth parents, foster parents, kinship caregivers, social work staff and allies.
- Learn about local resources for parents, foster parents, kinship caregivers, social work staff and allies.
- Explore next steps in building a community of birth parents, foster parents and kinship caregivers committed to promoting the value of partnership.
